



2014 Tournament Recap

July 14, 2014 | Tournament #3 on East & West Rush Lake was held yesterday and anglers faced a challenging post-frontal fishery with waters on both lakes being the dirtiest that they have been in a long time! With varying amount of success, The DD's claimed their first WBT title and helped to also muddy up the WBT Team of the Year point standings! Here's how the top winners did!

Big Bass #2– 4.55 lbs – Shake 'N Bake: *Lucas Matzke and Derek Born* caught the 2nd largest bass for the day and earned them \$40.

4th Place – 11.35 lbs – Flippin' Ain't Easy: *Rob Bolke and Aaron Schmoltdt* cashed their first check of the year with a bag anchored by a 4.05lb bass and earning \$25. The boys had to jump around to various spots to get their fish with a sporadic bite reported.

3rd Place – 13.10 lbs – Last Cast: These guys tried to duplicate the weedline pattern from the day before while pre-fishing, but *Paul Hecht and Mark Wessel* instead had to rely on skipping senkos under flooded shoreline trees and other spots. Consecutive 3rd place finishes help to shoot these guys near the top of the leaderboard and earning another \$95!

2nd Place – 13.25 lbs – Flippin' & Lippin': *Mike Doughty and Tim Krebs* picked off fish off various docks including the biggest bass of the tourney worth \$100 to combine with their 2nd place finish and \$185. After a slow start this year, the 2011 team champs are looking to continue making up ground in the team of the year race!

1st Place – 15.35 lbs – The Double D's: Finding shoreline edges that had adjacent hard bottom, Dan Dornbush and Dan Lindahl grabbed their highest tourney finish, anchored by a 4.50 lb big 'un. Their top finish earned them \$225 and resulting picture made Dane an internet sensation overnight!
