



## 2014 Tournament Recap

**July 27, 2014** | Just in time for the no-wake restriction to be lifted, the WBT took over Lake Minnetonka! A mix of weather during the week and a cold front that rolled through the day of the tourney resulted in a tougher tournament. Here's how the top winners did!

**Big Bass #1– 5.10 lbs – Flippin' Ain't Easy:** *Rob Bolke and Aaron Schmoldt* found this hawg on rocks in the main lake basin earning them \$100 and claiming the biggest bass for the year.

**4th Place – 11.45 lbs – Gotta Have More Cowbell:** *Jesse Larson and Rocky Novak* cashed their first check of the year with a bag anchored by the second biggest bass of the tourney (4.10lb) which was good for \$40 and caught on a horny toad. 4th place added \$25 to their take home as well.

**3rd Place – 11.85 lbs – Silver Lining:** With this finish, this team built on their team of the year pointes lead. *Jeremie Larson and Bruce Larson* nabbed their fish in various areas with jigs being the hot ticket. Besides critical points, they also earned \$95 to their pocket.

**2nd Place – 13.25 lbs – The DD's:** These guys matched their weight with the first place winners, but lost the tie breaker on the big bass scales. Dane Dornbush and Dan Lindahl used the wind to point jump and covering water. Their 2nd place finish gave them \$185 and out them only 3 points behind in the team of the year race!

**1st Place – 13.25 lbs – Keepin' It Reel:** *Jay Masters and Jerry Netland* also covered water with the windy conditions. Yet it was their 3.95lb bass that put them as the top boat for the day ahead of the DD's. Their top finish earned them \$225, congratulations!
