



## 2014 Tournament Recap

**August 18, 2014** | The WBT took on The St. Croix and Mississippi Rivers and the fishing was much different than many teams expected. Various factors contributed to the day - a tough bite with *only two limits caught*, fish positioning, current, and boat problems for the Bassassins. After the tourney, Lucas Matzke presented three Clam Rod Slicks to each angler showing just another benefit of being in the WBT - here's how the top winners did!

**4th Place – 6.70 lbs – Flippin' & Lippin':** *Mike Doughty and Tim Krebs* didn't get their limit but it didn't matter as they grabbed 4th place, critical team of the year points, and \$25.

**3rd Place – 7.65 lbs – Last Cast:** *Paul Hecht and Mark Wessel* were able to bring in one of the two limits to the scales today receiving key team of the year points and \$95 into their pocket.

**2nd Place – 8.00 lbs – The Bass Whisperers:** *Jeremy Abbott and (sub) Loren Jannett* added \$145 to the season earnings by fishing bridge pylons in 20-25 feet of water. Dropshots with craw worms and senkos, plus dragging tube baits through the brush put four fish in their livewell This is the "Whisperers" second, 2nd place finish this season earning them \$145. They also caught the second largest bass of the day for an additional \$40!

**1st Place – 11.20 lbs – Shake N' Bake:** *Lucas Matzke and Derek Born* covered a lot of water visiting the Interstate 94 bridge and the Red Wing Dam during their hunt for the winning bag. They were able to bring in one of only two limits caught today and the big bass (2.95lbs). They earned \$225 for 1st and another \$100 for big bass, congratulations!
